## Workshops

Our free workshops focus on the 'choices and consequences' surrounding crime and increasing awareness of Fearless.org, a service where young people can report crime 100% anonymously and access non-judgemental advice and guidance.

The sessions are fast paced, emotive and engaging. In order to increase the impact on young people we use a lot of audio and visual activities, including role play and interactive games with prizes! Sessions are aimed at young people aged between 11-16 but we can adapt the workshops for both younger and older audiences. The content is flexible and can also be differentiated for your audience.
